- Interesting Facts:**
- 1.) Daniel is one of the few well-known biblical characters about whom nothing negative is written. Three times Daniel is mentioned by his 6th century counterpart, Ezekiel, as an example of righteousness. (Ezekiel 9:23; 10:11, 19)
  - 2.) The first six chapters are written in the third person, while the last six chapters are written in the first person.
  - 3.) During the reign of Darius, a plot against Daniel results in his being put in the den of lions. At a minimum, Daniel would be at least 82 years old when that occurred.
