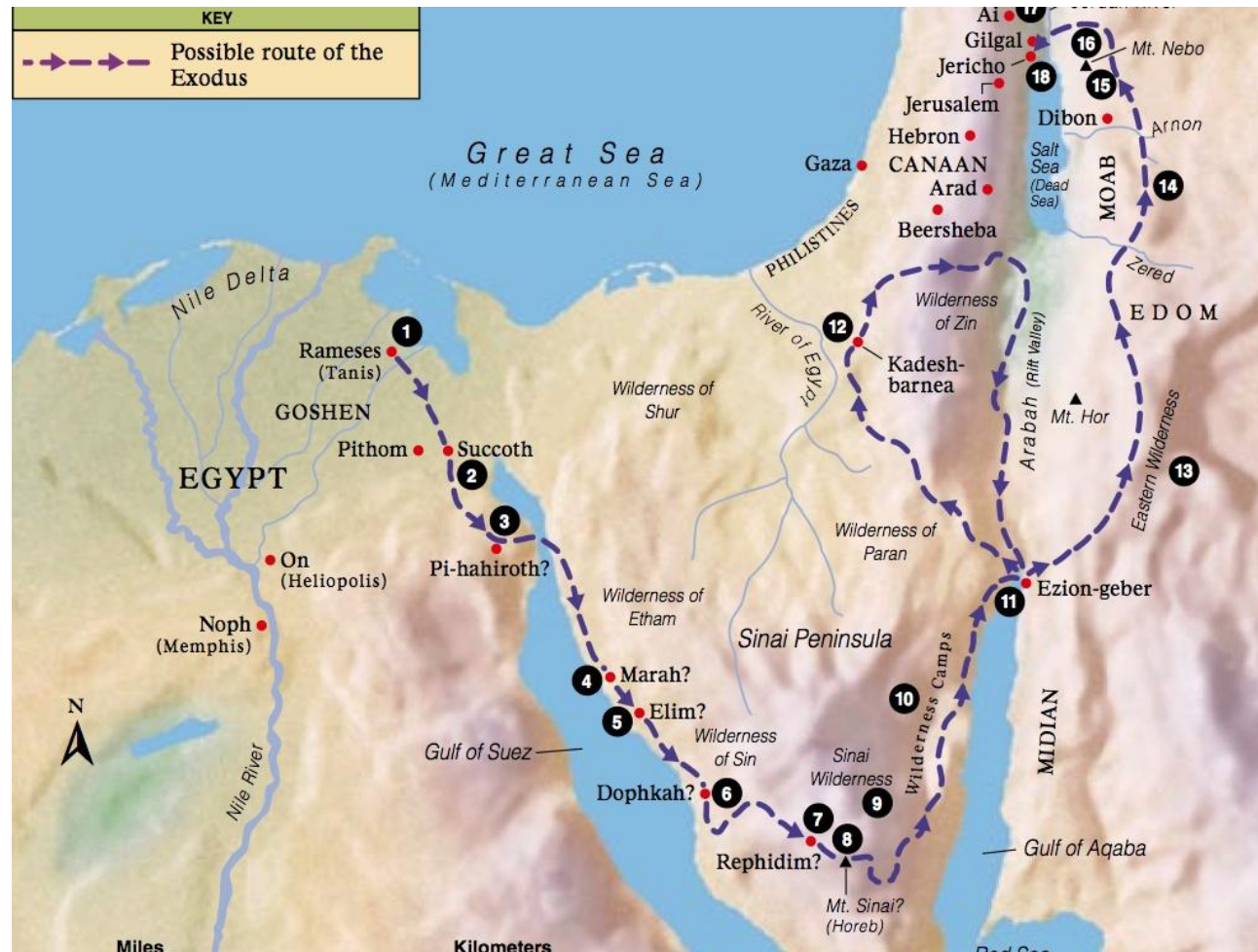

- Then the Lord said, “Behold, there is a place by Me, and you shall stand there on the rock.” (Exodus 33:21)

- In Exodus 12:14, 15 God told the Israelites to commemorate the Passover by eating bread made without yeast. Jewish people still commemorate this event today.

THE BOOK OF EXODUS

◉ Interesting Facts:

- In Exodus 12:14, 15 God told the Israelites to commemorate the Passover by eating bread made without yeast. Jewish people still commemorate this event today.
- 70 Israelites originally entered Egypt in Exodus 1:5. 430 years later 600,000 men, not including women and children, left Egypt. (Exodus 12:37-41)

THE BOOK OF EXODUS

- ◎ What is my take away?
 - God's dealings with the Israelites proves that He is a loving and patient God, always providing a way of escape for His children. Yet He chastises those whom He loves.
