1. Haggai is second only to Obadiah in brevity among the books of the Old Testament.
  2. At the time of the book of Haggai, it had been 16 years since the initial work on rebuilding the Temple had begun.
    - The work began in 536 B.C.
    - The work stopped in 534 B.C.
    - The work resumed in 520 B.C.
    - The work was completed in 516 B.C.
