**Who wrote it?** It is anonymous, but attributed to \_\_\_\_\_ “the disciple whom Jesus loved” (13:23; 21:21, 24). John and his brother \_\_\_\_\_ were fishermen with their father Zebedee. Jesus called John and James the “Sons of \_\_\_\_\_” (Mark 3:17; Luke 9:51-55).
