THE BOOK OF LEVITICUS

◎ Cast of Characters:

- God
- Moses
- Aaron, takes his role as Priest. (Lev. 8)
- Nadab and Abihu, sons of Aaron who die before the presence of God. (Lev. 10)
- Eleazar and Ithamar, surviving sons of Aaron. (Lev. 10; Num. 3:1-4)
- The son of Shelomith, a blasphemer who is stoned. (Lev. 24:10-16)

- The priesthood in Chaps. 21 and 22 foreshadow Christ as the ultimate High Priest. (Heb. Chap. 9)

 - For I am the Lord who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God; thus you shall be holy, for I am holy. (Lev. 11:45)

- Leviticus introduced seven religious feasts or festivals, which are Passover, Feast of Unleavened Bread, Day of First Fruits, Feast of Pentecost, Day of Trumpets, Day of Atonement, Feast of Tabernacles.
